

Helpful Hints

1. Browser preference:

- a. Edge or Firefox. It will run faster without the potential loading errors

2. Which report is useful for:

- a. Find a transaction for a specific date – Revenue & Expense Transaction
- b. Balance in a Department/Speedtype – Budget to Actual Reporting
- c. Balance of a faculty's research account – All Funds Fund Balance Report

3. Color difference of numbers:

- a. The blue numbers are clickable links, that will open in a new tab showing the detail that makes up that number

4. Patience is important with EBI:

- a. Remember to look for the status light next to the Sign Out button.



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5. How to interpret parenthesis:

- a. Budget to Actual – Remember that this report is **budget (+)** minus **total charges** plus or minus transfers
 - If the balance is overall positive, it means there are funds available
 - If the balance is overall negative, that *potentially* means an overspend
 - Transfers in (i.e., additional funds into the department/ST) will show a negative because it offsets spending
 - Transfer out is the opposite, a reduction of funds in the department/ST
 - Returns/Refunds will be shown in parenthesis so that it zeros out the original transaction

- b. All Funds – Remember that this report is **revenue (-)** plus **total charges (+)** plus or minus transfers
 - If the overall balance is negative, that means there are funds available
 - If the overall balance is positive, that *potentially* means an overspend
 - Transfers in (i.e., additional funds into the project/ST) will show a negative because it is an increase in funds
 - Transfers out is the opposite, a reduction of funds in the project/ST
 - Returns/Refunds will be shown in parenthesis so that it zeros out the original transaction

- c. Revenue & Expense – Best answer is it depends
 - Revenue is shown with parenthesis
 - Expenses are shown without parenthesis
 - Transfers in (i.e., additional funds into the department/ST) will show a negative because it offsets spending
 - Transfers out is the opposite, a reduction of funds in the department/ST
 - Returns/Refunds will be shown in parenthesis so that it zeros out the original transaction
